## NAVAJO NATION JUDICIAL BRANCH TO REMAIN OPEN

The Judicial Branch of the Navajo Nation remains open during the national emergency over the covid-19 until further notice.

A national state of emergency was declared today by President Donald Trump. A public health state of emergency was declared by the Navajo Nation on Wednesday, March 11, 2020.

Judicial Branch employees are on a travel restriction beginning today prohibiting travel off the Navajo Nation and allowing only essential travel within the Navajo Nation as determined by the respective supervisor.

During the Navajo Nation press conference on covid-19/novel coronavirus today, Chief Justice JoAnn Jayne said that a team of judicial staff is establishing procedures for continuity of services in the event of an emergency.

"The Navajo Nation Judicial Branch will strive to remain open, and to provide justice services and other mission critical functions," she said.

Judicial Branch district courts and facilities are asking that people do not enter if they have the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

If anyone has these symptoms and needs to enter a Judicial Branch facility, please call ahead for instructions on what to do.
