PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

The Judicial Branch of the Navajo Nation will be closed to the public beginning Thursday, March 19, 2020, through Tuesday, March 24, 2020. The Branch will then re-open on Wednesday, March 25, 2020, with limited services.

An administrative order was issued to close the courts on those dates by Chief Justice JoAnn B. Jayne due to the public health emergency declared by the Navajo Nation concerning the coronavirus/covid-19. The closure gives Judicial Branch staff time to prepare the courts and programs to offer essential services in adherence to Navajo Nation law.

More information on the limited services will be released at a later date.
