CHINLE JUSTICE CENTER OPENS DOORS TO PUBLIC

The Chinle Judicial District began operations at its new location at the Chinle Justice Center on Navajo Route 27 in Chinle, Arizona, on October 9, 2017. The court, Peacemaking Program and Office of Probation and Parole Services for Chinle Judicial District now have office locations and will offer services at the new location.

The main telephone and fax line will remain the same. Telephone lines are limited at this time.

The new justice center features three hearing rooms and a peacemaking hogan.

"I'm pleased we have now reached the point to open our doors at the Chinle Judicial District in a brand-new facility," said acting Chief Justice Thomas J. Holgate. "We applaud each and every individuals and entity who has been involved from the initial planning to the completion of this project. It has been a cumbersome effort however it will be there and beneficial for the people to receive the much-needed services."
