PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT FROM RAMAH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

The Ramah Judicial District building is closed December 1, 2021, to December 14, 2021. Essential services will continue to be provided and staff will be working remotely during this time.

Please note that the Navajo Nation email system uses a sender verification system designed to eliminate spam, bulk and malicious emails. When emailing the courts from a non-Navajo Nation email address, senders should verify their email address by following the instructions sent back to their email. This will allow for emails to go through to the intended recipient.

The Ramah Judicial District Court will not have access to its regular telephone and fax lines or U.S. Mail during the building closure.
