### **PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT FROM DILKON JUDICIAL DISTRICT**

The Dilkon Judicial District court facility will be closed from December 7, 2020 through December 14, 2020. Essential court functions will continue during the building closure.

Documents will continue to be accepted for filing by email, USPS mail, or fax during the building closure.

Documents filed with the Court by email outside Court hours will be received the next Court day during normal Court hours (Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.). Please make sure all documents are signed.

To file by USPS mail, mail documents to HC 63 Box 787, Winslow, AZ 86047. There may be a delay in processing of documents sent by mail due to the building closure.

To file by fax during the building closure, fax documents "Attn: Dilkon Judicial District" to the Window Rock District Court at fax number (928) 871-7560. Documents sent to Dilkon Judicial District's fax number during the building closure will not be processed before December 15, 2020.

When filing documents, please call the Dilkon Judicial District Court to confirm that documents have been received.

All scheduled hearings continue to be held by teleconference. Please call the Court at (928) 551-2385 at least thirty (30) minutes before your hearing to confirm that it is taking place and for instructions on how to appear by telephone. If you have legal counsel, talk to your counsel before calling the Court.

There is no change in how the Court will accept or process fines or fees during this building closure.
